

1. Complete the Application for Admission at [www.ntcc.edu/admissions](http://www.ntcc.edu/admissions)

Select the appropriate link (New Student, Transfer, Returning, etc.)

2. Apply for Financial Aid at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) - NTCC School Code 016396

The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is used to determine eligibility for federal aid

3. Provide OFFICIAL transcripts (high school, GED, or college)

If you have complete more than 12 college credit hours AFTER graduation we will not need your high school or GED. Less than 12 hours will require one of those. You must provide ALL transcripts from EVERY college you have attended. All high school transcripts MUST have the Date of Graduation.

4. Provide OFFICIAL immunization record with proof of bacterial meningitis vaccination, or proof of exemption for all students 21 years of age or younger

5. Provide TSI Assessment or approved alternative placement test scores

Approved alternatives include: college level TAKS (STAAR), SAT, ACT, or completed college level coursework
