Empowering Students to Succeed.

- o Be a citizen of US or eligible noncitizen - (shall be verified prior to the individual's receipt of a grant)
- o Register with Selective Service, if required to do so - (confirmation required)
- o If convicted of a crime involving fraud in obtaining T 4 funds, have completed the repayment of such funds

Student must not:

- o Have borrowed in violation of the annual or aggregate loan limits
- o Have previously received a baccalaureate or professional degree
- o Have been convicted of any offense under any Federal or State law involving the possession or sale of a controlled substance for conduct that occurred during a period of enrollment for which the student was receiving any T4 aid
