

### Medical Assisting Program 2021 Application Packet

The goal of the medical assisting program is to prepare medical assistants who are competent in the cognitive (knowledge), psychonotor (skills), and affective (behavior) learning domains

The Medical Assisting program is a 24-north curiculum designed to prepare individuals to perform the duties of a nedical assistant who functions in an acute care clinical setting or physician is office in the areas of medical office administration, clinical lab procedures, and examining room assisting Upon completion of the program the graduate will be availed an Associate of Applied Science degree
